## **Student Aviation Club - Scholarship**

### Purpose and Amount of SAC Scholarship

ESA awards scholarships for members of the Student Aviation Club at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University once per semester. These scholarships are intended to promote and support sport aviation and reward SAC members who go above and beyond normal club involvement with both SAC and the ESA.

Each recipient receives a \$400 credit to be used with ESA. Funds may be used to pay for membership fees or flight time in one or more of ESA's divisions. No monetary funds are paid out directly to the recipient and use of flight or membership credit is tracked through our bookkeeping process on MyFBO. The scholarship credit must be used within 2 years before any unused funds become void.

### Publicity of Program

The SAC scholarship is advertised and promoted entirely through SAC at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University.

### Eligibility

In order to be eligible for this scholarship, a candidate must be a member of SAC, in good standing and have paid the semester dues by the fourth meeting of that semester. Members of the SAC are not eligible for scholarships while serving as an officer. Members may receive more than one scholarship during their membership but only once per semester. Activities that would be taken into consideration for selection would include: coordinating events, attending fund raisers and assisting with facility projects.

#### Application and Selection Process

SAC Members who feel they are worthy of a scholarship shall provide a one page written statement no later than November 15th for the fall semester and April 15th for the spring semester to the officers of SAC. This statement should include the reasons why they deserve a scholarship and a brief description of their past involvement with both clubs. Written statements should be sent by e-mail to the SAC president by midnight of the deadline date.

#### Selection Criteria

The Selection is based on the contributions the candidate has made to SAC and ESA, not just participation level. Members who seek to promote the SAC and ESA through fund raisers, facility repair and other activities will be given priority. The selection committee reserves the right to change the type and number of scholarships granted each semester. The committee also reserves the right to not issue any scholarships if no worthy candidates are presented.
