## **“Safe Skies” Scholarship**

### Purpose and Amount of the Scholarship

ESA awards this safety oriented scholarship to a member other than the appointed head of safety. This scholarship is awarded to an individual who is always seeking for safety improvements and proposes new safety ideas and procedures. The Safe Skies Scholarship shall recognize a member who takes the initiative to improve the safety of the club.

The scholarship is awarded no more than two times per calendar year.

The recipient receives a \$200 credit to be used with ESA. Funds may be used to pay for flight time in one or more of ESA’s divisions. If the candidate is a member of the Sport Aviation Club (SAC) at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University but not ESA, the funds can be used towards the membership fee to join ESA. No monetary funds are paid out directly to the recipient and use of flight or membership credit is tracked through our bookkeeping process on MyFBO. The scholarship credit must be used within 2 years before any unused funds become void. Scholarships are non-transferable.

### Publicity of Program

The Safe Skies Scholarship is advertised and promoted through the ESA newsletter as well as at least at one general meeting.

### Eligibility

In order to be eligible for this scholarship, a candidate must be a current member of ESA and/or member of SAC. Members of ESA and/or SAC are not eligible for scholarships while serving as an officer. Members may receive more than one scholarship during their membership but a maximum of two per calendar year.

Activities that are taken into consideration for selection would include: continuous and proactive approach to safety within the club, proposal or initiative for safety procedures in one or more divisions, and other safety related involvement.

### Application and Selection Process

Any ESA and/or SAC member may apply for this scholarship or can recommend another candidate meeting the requirements for this scholarship.

The application shall:

- Include a brief personal description
- Include a summary of involvement specific to safety
- List various safety proposals and initiatives previously made by the candidate
- Highlight any other safety relevant activities with ESA
- Include one letter of recommendation attached to the application

Recommendations shall be sent by email or mail to the current ESA president and secretary. Recommendations must be received by midnight of the deadline date to be considered.

### Selection Criteria

The selection is based on the safety involvement of the candidate with ESA. The selection committee will consider the continuous and proactive approach to safety within the club, proposals or initiatives made for safety procedures in one or more divisions, as well as any other safety related involvement that has been submitted with the application.

The selection committee reserves the right to change the dollar amount and number of scholarships granted each year. The committee reserves the right not to issue the scholarship if the recommended candidates do not appear worthy of the award.
